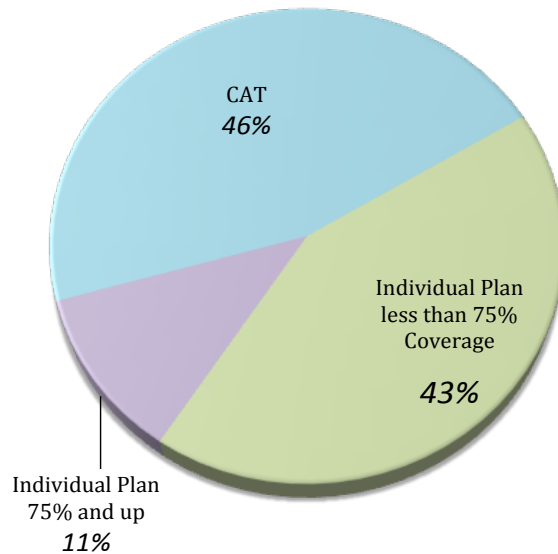

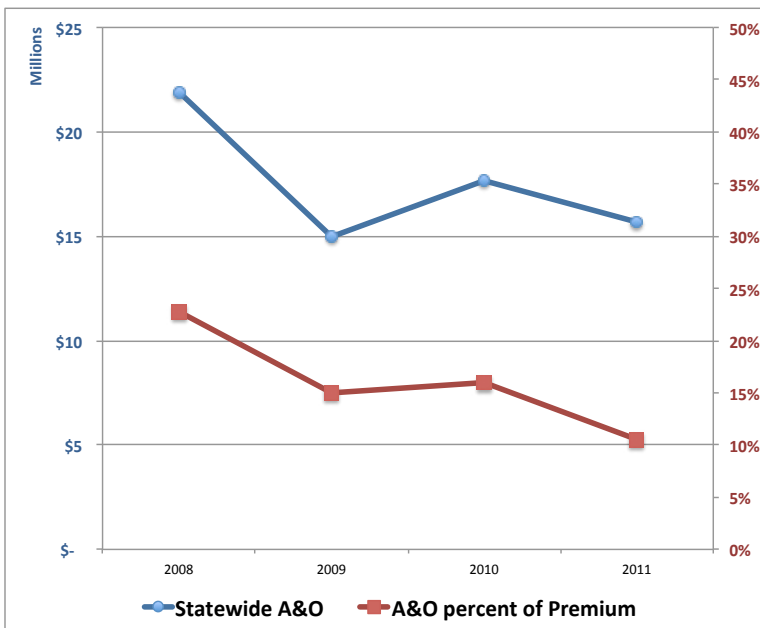

Of the 7.9 million acres planted in Arkansas in 2011, 5.1 million or 65% were enrolled in crop insurance. Of the insured acreage, 2.7 million were individual buy-up coverage, with 578,000 (11% of acres; 19% of premiums) with a buy-up level of 75% or greater. Over 2.1 million (46%) were in CAT .

The chart to the left highlights how the cost to the government to administer crop insurance in the state has been drastically cut since 2008, even as total liability within Arkansas has increased (from \$1.1 billion in 2010 to \$1.5 billion in 2011).
